## RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE USE OF REFRESH SYSTEMS

### MEASURES TO BE TAKEN BY REFRESH OPERATORS

Wash your hands often and thoroughly with soap and water, rubbing them well for at least 20 seconds, or use a hand sanitizer

Reinforce hand washing after blowing, before and after consuming food, after using the bathroom, after cleaning the hardware and whenever your hands feel or appear dirty

Do not share plates, drinking glasses, kitchen utensils, towels, bed linen or other house items

Clean and disinfect your hands before entering and after leaving the event site

Use an alcohol-based solution as an alternative for hand hygiene

Use single-use disposable paper tissues to blow

Dispose of used tissues in a waste bin and then wash your hands

Mandatory use of a face-mask at the event site

Cough or sneeze into your arm with the elbow flexed, and not to your hands, if for some reason of force majeure, you are not wearing a mask

Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth with hands that are dirty or contaminated with respiratory secretions

Whenever possible seek to keep a safe distance from other people of at least 2mt

Avoid close contact with people with signs and symptoms of acute respiratory infections

Clean and disinfect all Refresh hardware, before assembly and after use (computers, tablets, cables, camcorders, etc...)

Clean and disinfect all Refresh hardware, at the end of the day and before the start of the event (in cases where the system stays mounted)

Clean and disinfect the Judges' terminals, before the start of each heat and especially when there is a change of judges

Clean and disinfect any material used before assembly and before storage

For health reasons and while the COVID19 Pandemic lasts, Refresh does not provide plasticized Judge sheets and respective markers

In the event of using markers and or pens, these should only be used by the operator

Location of the operator (preferably behind the judges) with a distance of 2mt

It is the responsibility of the operator to check the necessary equipment to be transported to the event as well as to verify that it also carries all the necessary hygiene equipment

Any worker with symptoms such as cough, fever, difficulty breathing should not be present at the event, ensuring that the situation is reported to Refresh and the organization / production of the event
